**Advice to all stand holders and conditions**

**Location**

The Old Buckenham Air Show will be held in the grounds of the airfield at Abbey Road, Old Buckenham, Norfolk. This is located 4 miles from the A11 near Snetterton and Attleborough, just off the B1077

**Preparation**

Exhibitors can set up their stands **from 0800 on Sunday**. The event will be open to the public from 0900. Exhibitors who have stands will be permitted to stay overnight in caravans providing prior permission has been applied for and approved. Please remember that whilst every effort will be made to protect property it is recommended that your property be fully insured. The public and the exhibitors can purchase refreshments and light meals on the airfield. The sale of food and drink from your stand is prohibited unless a TAC Ltd approved food and drink stand.

**Passes**

Two free adult entry passes and one vehicle pass will be provided in early June. Vehicle passes should be displayed on the **top right hand corner of your windscreen**. Additional entrants will be required to pay for their tickets on the day at the appropriate rate.

**Stand Specification**

The stand area will be advised to exhibitors on arrival. Please make best use of the space available – which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

**No facilities** (apart from public portable toilets) will be provided by TAC so exhibitors must bring everything they require.

**Liability and Regulations**

TAC may cancel the event for any reason without recourse or liability. No stand holder's costs or any refund will be borne by TAC Ltd. Stand holders will ensure that their stand and surrounding area will not cause or hinder the exodus of people at the event for any emergency.

At the end of the event stand holders will be required to make tidy and remove all rubbish around their stand and within the stand area.

**Property & Third Party Liability**

Your attention is drawn to the fact that your staff at the event are at all times responsible for any property they may bring to the airfield. All exhibitors are required to comply at all times with the reasonable directions of the staff or helpers at the Aero Centre. TAC Ltd does not accept any claim for loss or damage to anyone's property, howsoever caused. Every exhibitor shall indemnify TAC Ltd against any infringement of copyright and other property rights

**Every product exhibited** shall be at the sole risk of the exhibitor. All exhibitors shall be covered by £5million public liability cover. If applicable, a copy of food hygiene certificates must be available for inspection for all staff handling foods

**Third Party Liability Insurance**

It is a condition of attendance that all exhibitors have adequate insurance in place against all insurance risks for destruction or theft, fire or damage to property brought to this event

**Applicable Law**
